

INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN'S OUTREACH NEEDS LIST 2010

Listed below are needs for the Belarusian children for this summer and beyond. If you or your group is interested in helping with this exciting ministry, please call Harold or Katie Moore at 891-5544.

Needs for Nastiya Sudziankova & the Moore Family and Hanna Hlushakova and the Booker Family for summer 2010:

Needed prior to arrival:

- Prayers
- Gift cards for
 - Wal-Mart
 - Office Max or Staples
 - Target
 - Rack Room Shoes
 - CVS
 - Ingles
- Size 12-14 and 14/16 girls clothing (gently used, if you know of anyone with this size, please set aside). They will need summer clothing to wear while they are here and fall/winter clothing to take home.
- Thank you cards
- Stamps
- Deodorant
- 2 boxes Advil liquigels (1 for each girl)
- 1 box Bonine chewable motion sickness medication
- International phone card (for Belarus)...so they can call their parents while they are here
- 1 Russian-English Bible to use while here
- 1 Russian Bible to take home
- Russian books (appropriate for a 12-13 year old girl)
- Russian-English picture dictionary
- Lots of Gum (without xylitol – it gives Nastiya headaches)
- Disposable latex-free gloves (medical type)
- Journal (1 for each girl to record their experiences while here)
- Colorful pens/pencils
- Stickers

Needed during their visit:

- Prayers
- Provide a meal for the family
- Provide interpreter services for medical appointments and/or church services (Russian/English)
- Create a scrapbook for Nastiya, Hanna and/or family
- Be a support family-requires background check (need to know ahead of their arrival)

Needed for their return trip home:

- Prayers
- Size 12-14 and 14-16 girls clothing (gently used, if you know of anyone with this size, please set aside). They will need fall/winter clothing to take home.
- 2 boxes Cold medication (tablets) (1 for each girl)
- 1 or 2 containers Instant coffee
- 2 Act Fluoride rinse (1 for each girl)
- 8 tubes Fluoride Toothpaste (4 for each girl)

- Vitamins (children's & Adult)
- Batteries (AA)
- Several Toothbrushes
- 2 boxes Advil liquigels (1 for each girl)
- 1 box Bonine chewable motion sickness medication
- 2 tubes Antibiotic ointment (like Neosporin) (1 for each girl)
- 2 boxes Band-aids (1 for each girl)
- Backpacks (1 for each girl) –Nastiya's favorite color is red and Anna's is red or violet
- Several packages of Beef Jerky (plain)
- 4 packages of nuts, seeds and raisins trail mixes
- 2 packages of granola
- Battery-powered flashlight or crank flashlight/radio
- Suitcases
- School supplies (not paper though, they use a different size)

Needs for an ongoing ICO Fletcher mission to bring Nastiya, Hanna and others to loving Christian homes in 2011 and beyond:

- Prayers
- Join the ICO mission team-all team members will be required to attend a monthly meeting.
 - **Fundraising Coordinator** – Responsible for raising the funds necessary to cover the costs of airfare and visas for the children and chaperone(s) and any administrative costs for the program. Includes creating fundraising opportunities, getting volunteers and overseeing all aspects of each fundraiser.
 - **Support Family Coordinator**-Responsible for finding, training and ministering to the support families. Each host family must have a support family.
 - **Medical Coordinator** – Responsible for finding Pediatrician(s), Dentist(s), Eye Doctor(s), and lab facility willing to donate their services for a checkup and any necessary services for each child and chaperone. Also, to make appointments for each person.
 - **Activities Coordinator**- Responsible for creating/scheduling events and activities for the children/chaperone, host families, and support families. It is important that the children have several opportunities to interact with one another and with the chaperone while they are here.
 - **Meals Coordinator**- Responsible for getting volunteers to provide meals for the host families during the children's visit.
 - **Host Family**- Christian families willing to host an at-risk child in your home for 6 weeks during the summer. It is recommended that host families host children of the same sex and similar age to other children in the home. Children range in age from 7-16 years of age.
 - **Support Family**-You will be paired with a host family. Your main responsibility is to be a back-up for the host family in the event that the host family is unable to fulfill that role (i.e. due to job loss, illness, death in family, move, etc.). Also, the support family may assist the host family by taking the Belarusian child to an activity, for an overnight, to an appointment, etc. Or you may be able to assist the family by providing babysitting services for the Belarusian child and/or the host family children.
- Monetary Donations. It costs approximately \$2,000 per child to obtain travel arrangements and visas. We hope to host 4 children and a chaperone next year. We will need to raise about \$10,000 for 2011!!!
